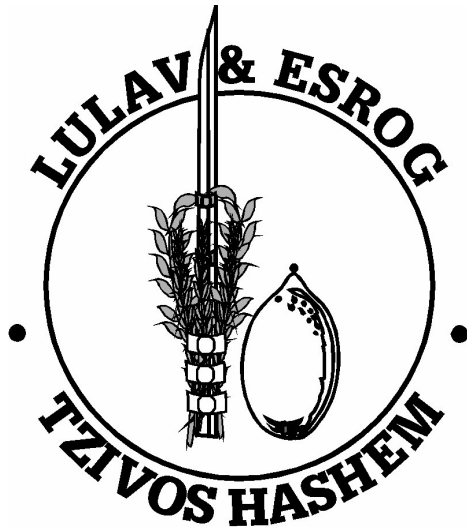

  - smelling fruits & vegetables
  - being *b'simcha* - happy
  - by gardening
  - inviting friends to participate in our sukkah
  - visiting friends & neighbors sukkahs
- How high can a Sukkah be?
  - 20 cubits
  - 5 feet

- What do we cover the Sukkah with?
  - chametz*
  - a tarp (*in case of rain*)

  - 18 Hadasim - 7 Aravot
- What 4 species make up the 4 kinds?
  - Guava, Pine branch, Oak leaves, Lemon
  - Date Palm, Citron, Myrtle, Willow,
  - Lulav, Etrog, Hadas, Arava
  - b & c
- What bracha do we make on the Lulav?
  - Hamotzi Lechem min Ha'Aretz
  - Al Netilat Yadayim
  - Borei Minei Mezonot
  - Al Netilat Lulav
  - Shehecheyanu
- Which hand do we hold the Lulav in when we make the Brachot?
  - left hand
  - right hand
  - underhand
  - both hands
- How do we tie up the species together?
  - with a rubber band
  - with rope
  - with Lulav leaves
  - with tape
- If one of the species are missing, can we still make a bracha on the Lulav?
  - it depends which one is missing
  - you use an olive branch instead
  - no way!
  - only on the Etrog
- What defect (s) makes an Etrog invalid or non-kosher (*pasul*)?
  - yellow color
  - a small hole or scratch
  - too bumpy
  - black specks
  - a broken *pitum*
